



How To Guide: Print Your Official Game Roster

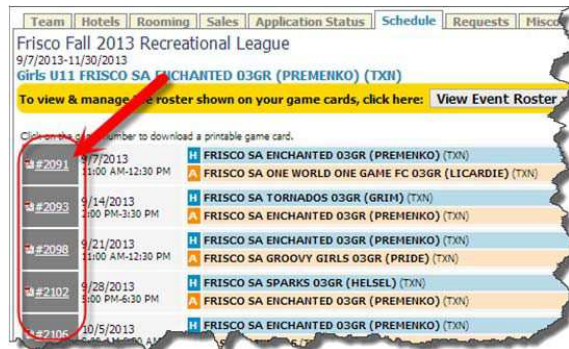
Coaches are responsible for printing two copies of their official roster prior to the start of the game. One copy is required by the referee to start the game. The second copy is to be kept by the coach. This is helpful for a variety of reasons, including taking notes during the game and reporting scores after the game.

To print the official game roster:

1. From your team account on gotsoccer.com, click the View link in the Schedules column



2. Click the PDF link found on the left of your game date and time. This is your “game card” and Official Roster for the game.



3. Print two (2) copies of the roster for your game. Give one to the referee, and keep the other for yourself.



HINT: Be sure to note the Event ID, PIN, and Game number. You'll need these to report your score after the game.
